


Rankings and Distinctions

Admission Requirements

UNDERGRADUATE

- · High school diploma or graduation certificate
- Minimum high school GPA 3.0 for freshmen students, transfer students must have GPA 2.0 on college/university coursework
- Official sealed transcript (no copies will be accepted)
- TOEFL iBT 61 or IELTS 6.0
- Financial statement of \$30,407 is required
- Copy of passport biographic page

GRADUATE/POST GRADUATE

- Equivalent to a U.S. 4-year bachelor's degree or diploma
- Minimum GPA of 2.5 on final two years (3.0 recommended)
 Note: most departments require a higher GPA
- Official sealed transcript (no copies will be accepted)
- TOEFL iBT 80 or IELTS 7.0
 - *Note:* individual departments may have higher English proficiency or other test requirements
- Financial statement of \$29,411 is required
- · Copy of passport biographic page

Individual program requirements (e.g. department application, recommendation letters, resumes or additional tests, etc.) must be sent directly to your major's department office.

Conditional Admission/Eligibility Program

SJSU offers conditional admission/eligibility to both undergraduate and graduate students who are academically qualified. Conditional Admission/Eligibility is a program designed for students who would like to study at SJSU but do not have sufficient TOEFL or IELTS scores. Students accepted to this program will study English at SJSU's language program, International Gateways. They will receive a letter of conditional eligibility (for a specific major) from SJSU and an I-20 that is issued by International Gateways for ESL study.
